1. The Cherbourg Aboriginal Shire Council has approved the creation of a new position of Environmental Health Worker*. (*Aboriginal Identified Position) The successful applicant must hold or be willing to obtain a Certificate IV in Indigenous Environmental Health or equivalent
2. The Environmental Health Worker(EHW) reports directly to the Operations Manager
3. The EHW is responsible for:
 - a. Implement and monitor the following environmental health activities within the community, including food safety, water and sanitation, waste management, vector control and pest control.
 - b. Work along with Animal Management Worker to assist with annual visiting vet program.
 - c. Work with internal and external stakeholders within environmental health activities.
 - d. Demonstrate ability or ability to acquire knowledge in the interpretation of environmental health legislation at relevant local and state level.
 - e. Demonstrate ability to work with relevant state government agencies to deliver routine environmental health services within the community, such as within the area of food safety, water and sanitation, waste management, health promotion and vector and pest control.
4. The role involves compliance and monitoring of services provided by Council
5. Comply with funding guidelines from QLD Health Public Health Program.
6. Provide a monthly report to the Operations Manager
7. Other duties that may be requested by the Operations Manager
8. Knowledge of local government governance requirements.
